We have a dark gray or black hard box which is on the ground and also embedded slightly into the ground, the box has two thin flap doors on the top surface which can fling open, inside the box is hollow space which contains gold metal parts and a thin yellow antenna which can rise up from the box once the doors are opened. The box creates a boom which causes the air to oscillate, producing sound waves in the air medium which transmit communication in a robot sounding voice, the sound waves travel away from the antenna. There is a red curved element with coarse texture, on it a coiled spring can bounce up, possibly the same element as the antenna that bounces up from the box. There is a yellow light bulb with long pine cone shape, obviously containing the metal filiment that shines encased by a glass. There is also a glass arch that cups over above our device, possibly the same element as the glass of the light bulb. There is a thin metal flap on the side which when pressed with finger it pryes parts open inside the box.

The Eiffel Tower is a wrought iron lattice tower on the Champ de Mars in Paris, France. It is named after the engineer Gustave Eiffel, whose company designed and built the tower. Constructed from 1887–89 as the entrance to the 1889 Worlds Fair, it was initially criticized by some of France leading artists and intellectuals for its design, but it has become a global cultural icon of France and one of the most recognisable structures in the world. The tower is 324 metres (1,063 ft) tall, about the same height as an 81-storey building, and the tallest structure in Paris. Its base is square, measuring 125 metres (410 ft) on each side. During its construction, the Eiffel Tower surpassed the Washington Monument to become the tallest man-made structure in the world, a title it held for 41 years until the Chrysler Building in New York City was finished in 1930. Excluding transmitters, the Eiffel Tower is the second tallest structure in France after the Millau Viaduct. Bastille Day is the common name given in English-speaking countries/lands to the French National Day, which is celebrated on the 14th of July each year. The French National Day is the anniversary of Storming of the Bastille on 14 July 1789, a turning point of the French Revolution, as well as the Fête de la Fédération which celebrated the unity of the French people on 14 July 1790. Celebrations are held throughout France. The oldest and largest regular military parade in Europe is held on the morning of 14 July, on the Champs-Élysées in Paris in front of the President of the Republic, along with other French officials and foreign guests.
