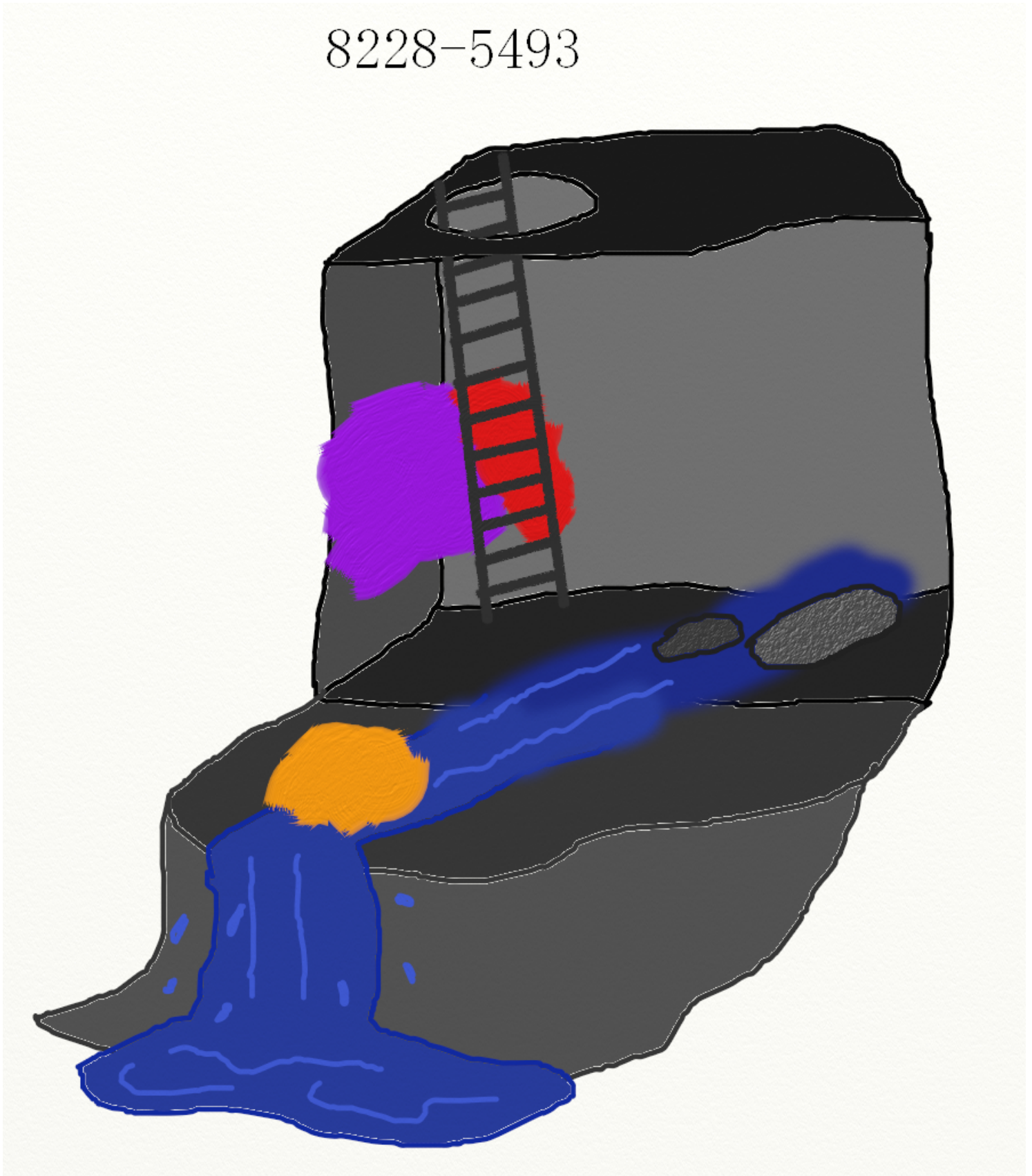

# Jonathan Run Falls

Jonathan Run Falls is in Pennsylvania's Ohiopyle State Park. This is a large park with a town inside of it. These falls are on the northern end of the park.

There are two main waterfalls on Jonathan Run and a third waterfall on the nearby Sugar Run. The falls on Jonathan Run are about 10 feet high each. The falls on Sugar Run is about 20 feet high. The falls can all be seen by taking the Sugar Run Trail starting at the Old Mitchell Place until you reach the Jonathan Run Trail. Take a left. You will reach the Youghiogheny River Trail, which looks like it used to be a railroad grade. The Kentuck Trail will take you past the Sugar Run Falls and lead you back to the Old Mitchell Place.

Getting a close look at the Johnathan Run falls requires you to leave the trail. A good view of the second fall in particular requires a somewhat difficult descent into the gorge. The Sugar Run Falls is right by the trail and easy to see. It had been raining heavily during my visit, so the creek was quite full. Normally the falls are probably not so impressive.
