This is a summary from the actual text report which is longer.

The target has a distinctly military feel. I find a person who is wearing camouflage clothing of a yellow-beige-brown coloration and dark military boots. I see this person doing various military exercises such as crawling on the belly on the ground, jumping up and down in one spot, and jogging fast in one spot, it seems to be a military recruit in training.

The target story takes place in five locations. One location is a forest during daytime, there are leaf trees and a gravel path through the forest which leads up the path to a room which feels like bomb shelter but looks like office, I had sensations of there being chemical weapons in that room.

The second location is out on a concrete or asphalt courtyard which looks empty except for one medium size military carrier aircraft which is brown on the outside. Its left side sliding door is wide open and forms a black rectangle on the left side of the dark inside through the open door. A small staircase of a few metal steps leads up into the aircraft. Our military recruit is standing on the yard on the left side of the aircraft and this person is feeling tremendously excited and happy to be there.

Third location is inside the aircraft. It is dark inside. The aircraft does not have a pilot, it is operated with remote control by means of a radio signal, I was personally very surprised and excited to come across this little detail! The aircraft is very powerful and strong, and a fantastic detail about it is that it flies very smoothly, in fact I found out that passenger aircraft for commercial use is low quality with bumpy rides compared to this secret (or expensive) technology. This airplane is somewhat small but heavy for its size. It is bigger than what one would call small airplanes.

Fourth location is out at the ocean, the water is unusually dark blue and forms many small waves that reach upward, instead of those long waves that would sweep slowly forward. There is white coral just underneath the water's surface. There is a significant island near this location out at sea, the island is a landscape of black volcanic glass with sharp pointy edges and surfaces that look like polished bits of black glass, the island has no trees there or grass or houses. There was however a town or city further down-right side from the island which is dense with houses.

Fifth location is inside of a small room, this is either the bomb shelter or is some other office somewhere. The colors are yellow and brown in this room. There is a table with the radio on the table, the people of this story are there, the people feel happy and excited.

If we go from the forest down a hill toward up-left side there is an encampment with a cafeteria and other buildings and is at the coast, the coast is not sandy beaches but has some of that black sharp

rock but not tall rocks there.

A significant item is a radio which looks like a brown rectangular box or briefcase, it was set on a table and is in the room. There is a handle on top of it and the significant person will grab that handle and hold on to it tight. On the front surface of the radio box is a round white circle which bulges outward like a speaker or a screen, across the white circle is a grid pattern. This circle was also seen superimposed over the blue ocean below and was then called a "search area" making it a large circle of ocean that was circled in and the gridlines to help with searching and mapping out.

I have also seen a large white sheet which is a map which has islands on it, this map has been folded many times so therefore it has many squares on it. This map has a coordinates which consists of 8 to 10 numbers. The map shows the location out at sea, down-right side from the black volcanic rock island, where an item has fallen into the sea.

The man or men in the room were listening to the radio and they were "intercepting" the radio transmission, as if they picked up a radio communication as this radio message was halfway. They were very happy to be doing this activity.

The central person who acted as a military recruit in training at the coastal military base and who stood next to the airplane at the yard, this person went into the airplane and is going to grab the handle that is on top of the brown radio or case. This person will jump out of the airplane through the open sliding door on the left side of the airplane. This person is holding the item, or the item falls by itself, into the ocean below the airplane. No boats are ever involved or out at sea during all these operations, it is important to know that all this transport is taking place by falling down from the airplane above the sea. When the item lands into the sea, there is an explosion which forms a thick pillar column of water to rise straight up, but no water spreads out to the sides, only up as a column of water.

Inside the brown case of interest, there is metal which reminds of aluminum. This item goes from the airplane and falls into the ocean either on its own or while being transported and carried by the person who jumped while holding on to it, most likely the person jumped also. When this metal lands on the water, this metal item opens itself up and spreads into a sheet, it reminds me of the Mars rover which lands and then opens up the flat solar panels, though this is into the ocean and this is not on Mars and this is military.

What do I make of all this? It deals with a military activity and a key word is transportation, an item was being transported on the airplane by this one very excited and happy person, and the item ended up in the sea. There is also an interest in terms of finding or knowing where this item has landed, on a map.

It would be tempting to imagine a dangerous scenario for an exciting remote viewing target, but I have felt nothing negative from this target, it is surprising how very happy and excited the persons involved are. The recruit is mostly happy about going into the airplane and getting to jump out of the airplane, and this person and if there was another person with this person in the room, they are more happy about the radio transmission that they "intercepted", than about the metal object itself. No one is really excited or happy about the metal object that was transported, so that metal

object is not the cause of their feelings, the radio signal is more interesting.

If any of this rings true, you will find lots more details in the actual, and lengthy, text report which I have also submitted.

I am using a method that I developed on my own from scratch, this is not CRV.

How I do my RV method

1. Initial stage: I look at target signal and collect initial elements, these jump out at me automatically, I list them at the bottom of the text report as IE. When they stop coming, or become repetitive, I begin the secondary stage.

2. First part of secondary stage is "interaction secondary stage", here I use no effort, but I interact with the listed elements. First I tap each of the listed elements gently, this provokes more information to wake up, like tapping at water forms ripples. I list these new findings under T for each element.

3. After tap I do a gentle probing, where I touch elements but without using effort, this provokes new information to appear, this is listed as GP for each element.

During secondary stage I may encounter new additional elements, I list these as SE for secondary elements.

4. Secondary stage effort, where I touch the elements but use effort, I do not do this on all elements usually but choose the ones that reappear from the target signal.

I also do a "tag chase" which is where I let the target guide me around and do some probing too. This leads to connections, elements finding their places, target identity starts to form.

I should do a third stage but did not in this session, where I do target landscape probing on the target landscape I have constructed at this point.

I did not run this session to its fullest, at one point the target signal suddenly went flat and the RV declared itself over, so I decided to end it there. I could continue on another day, but that would only lead to more clarity on element identity and target identity, I think this is good enough. If this target is very important, I can revisit it and probe to find out exactly who those people are, what the brown case/radio is, what precisely was dropped into the ocean, where on the world map this location out at sea is, what the military base is. It is a lot of work and a lot of time to go as far as that.
