Noetic Matching RV Test 1 Today March 8, 2019 10:51 PM

The Noetic website has a different kind of RV test. It is called the "Quick Remote Viewing Test". I get to choose one of 5, 10, 25, or 100 for the number of trials that are run one after the other, in each trial I choose one of five possible pictures as the target picture. I have to complete the set of all trials before getting my results only at the end. I have reservations before I do this for the first time, since the second protocol I tried in the past had the switching phenomenon when feedback is not provided after each trial. I will of course still try this protocol, but if this protocol fails to indicate RV then I do not hold it against the RV.

I choose the smallest, 5 trials per run.

I need to choose display results of "target+choices" or "target only" or "hits only", I choose "target+choices" because I want to see all of the relevant info.

I make a note here that I still have the flu so my effort stage might not be fully functional, but I am itching to do more RV I have not done any for the past few days and it is irresistible not to do some RV work. So if this fails I might have to try it when I am fully recovered again.

Since these five trials will be linked or grouped together, at least as far as the feedback stage is concerned, I will record all five consequtive sessions (trials) on this same page. I will also draw all five drawings on the same drawing program file but on separate layers.

SESSION 1 Start 10:56 PM

I feel nervous, or rather what I am feeling is excitement, and also it feels good to do RV again after a few days of not having been able to!

Ok. So this is the first trial ever of using this protocol on this target pool website. I did not know what to expect when I clicked for the first one, but as I had feared, the five picture options are presented already underneath the gray target box on the source page. I immediately cover them with my arm - but have already seen them vaguely, especially that one of them has significant blue water on it - and I minimize the internet browser window and change the frame size so that the pictures become hidden.

Ok I will now go about trying to RV the gray box, which has been successful in the past with the other Noetic protocol, but I know that logic will be trying to justify in the back of my mind whether the one with the blue water background is a reasonable choice, or not. I will try, or pretend, to go about this without any influence from logic.

I see and feel a tall brown tower structure on the right half of the picture, not fully against the border of the frame. It looks even in shape and cylindrical like a chimney or a tall pipe of some sort. There is something yellow like a chicken in the center of the picture. The tower on the right side is significant. The floor in the foreground, center and left, is smooth. The tower rises tall.

I probe the tower. There is significant yellow in the center of the image. I am actually excited about this format of RV, that I get to match it with a picture! (Am getting ahead of myself here, better stick to the session, but it should be ok to be happy about RV.) The brown thing could be a tree with tree branches on the top.

After drawing the impressions I have had so far, I return to look at the gray box, and yes I feel the tall structure on the right side. I will now look at the five pictures.

One is windmills with a foreground of a river, one is a white Roman style building with several white column pillars, one is the interior of a kitchen with chairs and wooden paneling, one if a human child wearing a huge round straw hat and facing the camera, and the fifth is a closeup of gray elephants one which has tusks.

I remember to take a print screen of the page for my records.

The elephants I do not recognize. The kitchen I do not recognize. The child I do not recognize. The pillars and the windmills perhaps. I think I need to probe the target some more. (We did have initial contamination for logic so this session might struggle due to that because I saw a glimpse of the five pics in the beginning, but anyway let's soldier on.)

I now leave the five pics showing and probe the gray box some more.

Looking at the picture options that I have, I think it a good idea to investigate the top of my pillar to see what is there.

The white pillar comes forth in two different ways. I will choose that one without probing it further, as I consider this session contaminated anyway (because I saw a glimpse of the pics, and you know how logic gets).

11:11 PM. My choice: Roman building with white pillars.

Oh gee! It displays the answer right away on that is wonderful! So I will save my drawing file as a file of its own. This target was the boy with the round hat.

Also each matching target will get its own file so this file ends here.

Feedback stage: I need to take at least 30 minutes for feedback and then at least one hour before

the next session, however since I have not been remote viewing for so long I will cheat a little and do the next target sooner than that.

I don't really have comments because I am sick and also the session was contaminated since I saw the pictures in the beginning.

I will now do the next session.
